Exam periods are 90 minutes. **Students may not take exams early.** **Students may not change exam times** (unless approved by the principal) - students who do so will receive an “**F**” on the exam from the office.

- ❖ Students must arrive to school before their first scheduled exam and should plan to leave after their last scheduled exam (unless they need to ride the bus). **Students may not leave in the middle of the day and return for a later exam.** Once they come to school, they stay until they are finished for that day.
- ❖ Since there are breaks after each exam, there should be no students out in the hall during exam time **for any reason.**
- ❖ All study halls will meet in the commons. Study Hall teachers will be responsible for watching the main doors. **Students will not be permitted to enter the classroom part of the building until each break time starts.** Students who arrive early should be directed into the commons. These students **cannot** go to their lockers.
- ❖ As per the student handbook (pg. 34/35): “Any student not appearing and/or not taking an exam at the scheduled time will receive an “F” on the exam and **will not receive credit for the course.** The only exception to this is if the student’s absence is excused. Cheating on a semester exam will result in no credit for the course and a W/F grade.”
- ❖ Students will be finished at 1:00. The buses will not run until 2:30. For the unfortunate few who cannot find a ride, there will be a study hall available for them in the cafeteria. Students who need extended time (only if provided for on the student’s active IEP or 504 plan) will be able to utilize the time after 1:00pm.
